

Are you eligible for R&D?

Is your business registered in the UK for Corporation Tax?



Sorry, to be eligible you must be a UK limited company.

Has the business done anything in the last 3 years that has been difficult and involved technical challenges?



Sorry, to be eligible you must have been working on a project to overcome technical challenges in the last 3 years.

Were the technical challenges related to improving an existing product, process or service; to make it better, cheaper or more efficient?



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3 YEARS

To be eligible you must be seeking to advance science or technology within your industry. You've not developed any new innovative products, processes or services, or made any improvements to existing products, processes or services in the last 3 years. Therefore, it is unlikely you have any qualifying R&D activity.

Did you use people with appropriate skills and experience to carry out the work?



To be eligible to make an R&D tax claim you must use people with appropriate skills and experience to carry out the work. As you've not used people with appropriate skills and experience it is unlikely you have any qualifying activity.

For the work carried out, have you incurred any internal or outsourced people costs, and any materials costs?



To be eligible to make an R&D tax claim you must employ staff or outsource to contractors, or spend money on materials.
